Offering Namaz on right time and with congregation is also very important and it helps one gain nearness and love of Allah. Life of Holy Prophet^{SA} is a very good path for us to follow in this regard as well. Hudur^{SA} would spend most of his night praying and asking for Allah's mercy and blessings. Holy Prophet^{SA} said once that,

Translation: Leave Namaz make one close to non-believer and idol worshipping.

Hadhrat Masih Ma'ud^{AS} said in Kashti-e-Nuh, that "whoever is not offering five daily prayers is not from my Jama'at".

In another place Hadhrat Masih Ma'ud^{AS} said, "Offer Namaz! Offer Namaz because it is the key to all goodness. When you stand for Namaz, don't stand like it is a custom, but first the way you do physical ablution, do spiritual ablution. Wash your limbs from anti-GOD thinking. Then with both ablutions, stand in front of Allah, and pray a lot, make habit of crying and weeping so that you will be shown mercy." (Azala Oham)

May Allah help us follow this very important teaching of the Holy Quran and help us establish our Namaz with both ablutions. Amin!
